### Import and export

In 2022, the U.S. experienced noteworthy trade activity in the steel and pipe industry, according to the U.S. Department of Commerce. Imports surged to \$31.6 billion, while exports amounted to \$20.5 billion, with Canada, Mexico, China, and the European Union emerging as the principal suppliers.

Steel and pipe materials, due to their weight and size, need robust packaging. For example, steel bars should be bundled or coiled for physical protection, while steel pipes and copper tubing should be stored in boxes or containers to prevent both damage and corrosion.

- Ensure proper packaging and wrapping.
- If the freight's size requires transportation on an open platform rather than an enclosed truck, it should be covered with waterproof tarpaulin.
